
New features

TPA Job multiple technician assignment


TPA Jobs now support assignment to more than one technician by assigning multiple technician IDs – this can be performed via the UI (if the account is licensed for SS-PRO or higher), and via the API (if licensed for SS-ENT-WRKFLW).

In the TPA Job Manager view, when more than one technician ID is assigned to a job, the 'Tech' column shows the text "Team" and the number of technicians assigned – clicking on the text provides a pop-up showing the technician IDs.

TPA Job template auto-deployment

TPA Job templates are now autodeployed to any user (and their associated instruments) in the organization (or sub-organizations) where the Job template is saved. Users who are added or moved to the job template's organization (or any sub-organization) have the Job template automatically deployed to them, and users who are moved outside of the job template's organization have the job template removed from their Mobile Tech app and/or test instruments upon the next sync with StrataSync.

A Job template can be moved to a different organization, which will remove deployment from the previous organization. Please note ORGANIZATION SETTINGS-Licenses for TPA option

TPA Summary and Detailed PDF reporting

When TPA jobs are approved (either manually or via auto-approval), StrataSync can generate a Summary and/or a Detailed PDF report, based on system-wide or perorganization settings. By default, reporting is disabled.

The Summary PDF report currently supports the JSON REPORT.FComp PRO test type (reports are effectively empty for jobs with other test types), and summarizes key metrics across all FiberComplete PRO test results associated with the approved job.


The Detailed PDF report concatenates any test results uploaded from VIAVI test instruments associated with the approved job which are PDF-formatted. Test results in other formats are not included. Please note that the StrataSync account must be licensed for SS-PRO or higher.

The auto-approval settings for jobs can now be configured system-wide, or perorganization. By default, auto-approval of jobs is disabled. Please note that the StrataSync account must be licensed for SS-PRO or higher.

StrataSync System Settings - Auto Approve Jobs Settings


General improvements / Bug fixes

Improvements

• LAW-X integration now retrieves StrataSync user profiles and the associated organizational structure to augment LAW-X user information facilitating user authentication and removing the administrative burden of having to maintain user profiles accurately across both systems.

Please note that the LAW-X system requires active licensing to support this integration.

- Updates to MCA III test configuration.
- The TPA Job Manager view shows an 'Approved jobs' count in the summary dashboard section which when clicked, filters the tabular view to show only approved jobs.



Known issues

- The Test Data list view which includes the column 'Test Duration MS' may show an 'Unexpected Application Error' if any of the other matching test data has been synced via the VIAVI Mobile Tech app. Users can use the 'Customize view' UI to deselect that column for reliable test data viewing. This issue will be resolved in a future release.
- Admin users associated with an organization at a higher level than a suborganization where TPA is enabled, will not see the TPA sub-menu from the existing StrataSync web UI to access the new TPA UI.
 - Workaround Create a new user profile associated with the TPA-enabled organization and login with this profile to access the new TPA UI. This issue will be resolved in a future release.
- When viewing instrument software options in the per-asset details, a floating option
 may appear both in the 'Software Options' list, as well as the 'Floating Software
 Options' list, depending on the sync state of the asset in question. All floating
 option counts, however, are calculated correctly. This issue will be resolved in a
 future release.

New test instrument support

TM100GB

The TM100GB module is now supported as a 'module' class asset type in StrataSync via direct sync from the ONA-800 platform and syncing with the VIAVI Mobile Tech app.
